Though piano provides the primary accompaniment and is the only necessary accompanying instrument, optional accompaniment parts for elementary orchestra and band allow student instrumentalists to participate.

Sing of Our School may be suitably adopted as a school song for commencements or graduations, and is meaningfully expressed any time school is celebrated.

\*The climactic final refrain may be personalized by substituting words that sing the school's name in Voice 2, Ms. 69 & 73 (example: "Washington School, O Washington School...") and in Ms. 81 & 87 ("Washington School, our school..."). To accommodate the potentially different syllabic stresses of the new words, creative teachers and students may compose different syncopated rhythms in these measures to effectively sing their particular school name. (The piano accompaniment in these measures should also be altered to support the vocal rhythms.)





\*If desirable and rhythmically appropriate, the school name may be substituted for the final exclamation in Ms. 88 & 89 (*example*: "Washington School!").
